



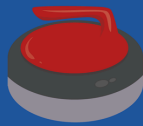
Welcome to our Newsletter!

Participating artists customize their birdhouses using weather-resistant materials, ensuring each piece is ready to be enjoyed outdoors. After completion, the finished birdhouses will be made available to the public for purchase through a fundraising auction held by the Lindsay Optimist Club.
